This educational conference endeavors to convene distinguished educators, scholars, technologists, and industry experts from around the globe to deliberate and examine the transformative impact of emerging technologies on higher education. Participants are invited to contribute their **original papers** (papers fully generated with the help of AI will not be accepted. Authors are permitted to use AI tools for polishing, improving language, or correcting grammar; however, the content must remain authentic and entirely original) for presentation during this conference related to higher education in the fields of Business Administration, Computer Science, Criminal Justice, and Education. The papers could be based on original research, surveys, case studies, or action plans that are not presented or published elsewhere. It should be submitted in MS Word format in a maximum of 3000 words (Works Cited and Notes included in the word count). The official language of this Conference is English; hence, all the abstracts, papers, and presentations will be in English.

Authors are invited to submit an abstract electronically to the Conference Committee Chair through email to conference@na.edu. Submissions should follow the APA style guidelines and be submitted in MS Word format.

Abstract submissions MUST include (A template is available at the end of this document)

- Name, title, institution, and email of all authors
- Title of proposed paper
- Abstract of a paper in Word format in 200-300 words
- A list of 5-10 keywords of the paper
- Declaration that the paper is not created with the help of AI or similar technology
- Brief biographical statement of all authors in Word format in a maximum of 200 words.

- Deadline for abstract submission: Friday, February 7, 2025, 5 pm CST
- Notification of acceptance of abstracts: Monday, February 10, 2025, 5 pm CST
- Deadline for full paper submission: Friday, March 21, 2025, 5 pm CST
- Notification of acceptance of full paper: Friday, March 28, 2025, 5 pm CST
- Conference registration deadline: Friday, April 11, 2025, 5 pm CST

Conference registration is required for all presenters and attendees. The registration form is available on the [conference website](#).

The registration fee for this conference is **US\$100**.

A 100% refund will be provided if the registration is canceled on or before May 1, 2025. No refund will be provided afterward. To cancel the registration, please send an email to conference@na.edu.

The Conference Committee reserves the right to permit online presentations in exceptional circumstances where authors should send their presentations and prerecorded videos by May 1, 2025. The registration fee will be the same for in-person and online presenters. Conference attendees other than the online presenters are expected to attend the conference in person.
