- Collaborate with the UMCR team to publish stats and game highlights on the Stallions' website and social media platforms.
- Assist in creating and updating media guides with accurate statistics and historical data.
- Regularly review stallions.na.edu for statistical accuracy & suggest improvements as needed.
- Be present at sporting events to gather real-time data & assist with media material collection
- Work closely with the streaming team during home games to ensure accurate stat integration.
